Subject: LEED Statement on SFS intec Flat Roof Fasteners

Dear Valued Customer:

Thank you for your continued business with SFS intec. We understand the need to be able to apply for LEED credits in today's construction industry, and further recognize the need for ourselves to collectively act in environmentally responsible manners in order to preserve our future. As such, please accept this letter as a statement on recycled content and region of origin of carbon steel materials used by SFS intec in the manufacture of flat roof fasteners.

Based on estimates provided by suppliers of steel to SFS intec and by the Steel Recycling Institute, it is estimated that carbon steel fasteners (fasteners and plates) manufactured by SFS intec for flat roof applications contain a minimum of 25% post-consumer recycled steel content.

Unfortunately, due to the number of raw materials and extraction sites relevant to this product, SFS is unable to make a blanket statement regarding the raw material extraction locations used in the production of this product.
